

Fourth and William Structure



Location: 115 East William Street
On the northwest corner of Fourth Avenue and William Street.

Interesting Facts: This is the largest structure in the city system, and it's located within a short distance of numerous restaurants, shops, and offices. A \$4 million repair project was completed in summer 2002 which included extensive concrete repairs, equipment and elevator repairs, and deck coating. In addition, a number of aesthetic improvements were also made including new canopied pedestrian entrances, new lighting, stainless steel elevator interiors, bicycle parking area, exterior and interior painting, and new parking office. In 2007, a \$5 million dollar project added approximately 140 new public parking spaces and a new speed ramp to the structure.

Size of Structure: 847 parking spaces, including 15 handicap-accessible spaces (height restriction 6'10" levels 1-3 and 6'6" level 3 and above)

Rates: Monthly parking permits are available at \$125/month. Premium monthly permits are available at \$175/month. Hourly parking is available Monday through Saturday at \$0.80/hour. Parking is provided free on Sundays and holidays.
